




FISH FOR THE FUTURE 2024

Dakshin Foundation is a non-profit organization that works towards natural resource conservation and management while promoting sustainable livelihoods, social development and environmental justice. In Lakshadweep, our work aims to strengthen fisheries co-management by engaging with the local fishing community and other fishery stakeholders. Through stakeholder participation, we hope to increase stewardship as well as provide a platform for policy-making and management.

Dakshin Foundation's community-based fisheries monitoring programme in Lakshadweep was co-created with fishers and began in January 2014 with the intention to involve fishers in knowledge generation and fisheries management. The larger aim of the programme is to strengthen the pole and line fishery to ensure sustainable livelihoods while preserving marine biodiversity. The programme is adapted from time to time to meet the requirements of the community.

Our work in the Lakshadweep Islands is supported by the Lakshadweep Administration, Department of Science and Technology, Department of Fisheries and Department of Environment and Forests.
