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# 1. GUIDE TO THE HANDBOOK

#### Who is this book for?

This book is for marine fishworkers, specifically, small-scale marine fishworkers in Tamil Nadu. Information on and subscription to the existing welfare and income-support schemes of the government was found to be low in predominantly small-scale marine fishing villages. This book has been compiled to disseminate information to marine fishworkers in Tamil Nadu and to improve access to existing government support. Additionally, the book also highlights schemes available for fisher youth and fisher women.

## How to access these schemes?

Most of the schemes in this book can be accessed by contacting the Assistant Director of Fisheries. The phone numbers and office address of the Assistant Director of Fisheries in Ramanathapuram District (where Dakshin Foundation is currently working with small-scale fishing communities) are mentioned at the end of this document. Fishworkers may also contact the Fisheries Department appointed Sub-inspectors and local Sagar Mitras, who have been given the role of facilitating various schemes and programmes at the village level.

## What all is included in this book?

The book is divided into five sections: Fisher Welfare Schemes, Marine Fisher Assets, Inland Fisheries and Aquaculture, Trainings and Fish Marketing. Each page covers one scheme and gives details of the entitlements, the eligibility for the scheme and how to apply for the scheme. In the online version, links to the claim forms for the schemes are also available. Claim forms can also be obtained from the respective Assistant Director of Fisheries.

# Does this book cover all the schemes that are made available by the government?

The book compiles information on key Department of Fisheries related schemes and subsidies. There are a large number (close to 200+) of other welfare schemes made available by other government departments such as Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, Agriculture and Horticulture Departments, Education Department, Women and Child Development, Livelihoods, among others that coastal communities are also eligible for. This booklet, however, does not provide information on schemes from other Departments.

# 2. ENTITLEMENTS OF MARINE FISHWORKERS IN TAMIL NADU

Marine fishworkers in Tamil Nadu are entitled to various rights and entitlements as outlined in the Constitution of India, as per various state and central government laws, policies and schemes, as well as through and international agreements, conventions and regional arrangements that India is signatory or party to such as the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea. Other non-binding documents such as the FAO's Code of Conduct for Responsible Fisheries and the Voluntary Guidelines for Securing Sustainable Small-Scale Fisheries (VGSSF) also guide India's approaches towards fishers' entitlements and their role in coastal and marine governance.

#### THE RIGHTS AND ENTITLEMENTS INCLUDE:

# 1. Right to livelihood

Drawn from Article 21 of the Constitution, for marine fishers, this right translates into the capability to access and utilise the resources of the sea and coastal areas for fishing and related activities without hindrance from exclusionary developmental projects. This represents an obligation on the part of the state to protect fishers from arbitrary and unlawful interference in carrying out activities related to their livelihood.

## 2. Right to social security

Marine fishers and particularly small-scale fishworkers often face significant marginalisation and other socio-economic barriers. As per the Tamil Nadu Fishermen and Labourers Engaged in Fishing and other Allied Activities (Social Security and Welfare) Act, 2007, fishers and allied 'beach workers' from marginalised groups are entitled to central and state social security benefits, such as the savings-cum-relief, pension and insurance schemes, adequate compensation in case of loss of livelihood or damage to property, among other programmes to secure their livelihoods in times of need.

# 3. Right to health and safety

Fishers work in dangerous physically demanding environments and are often exposed to life-threatening conditions while at work including fishing in rough seas, facing bad weather, security threats from neighbouring maritime countries, and inadequate safety equipment on board. Fishers, as workers, are thus not only entitled, through various local laws, access to medical care and health check-ups, compensation on account of death and disability due to fishing but also access to information on safe fishing practices.

# 4. Right to participate in the management of marine resources

Fishers have the right to participate in the management and conservation of marine resources, as their lives and livelihoods are directly dependent on healthy coasts and seas and its sustainable and equitable use. In Tamil Nadu, platforms to engage with government authorities on matters related to marine resource management include fisher co-operatives, fisher associations, district level committees for coastal management and other co-management and advisory boards.

## 5. Right to education

Fishers and their children have the right to education and should be provided with equal educational opportunities. This includes scholarships and reserved access to schools, colleges and fisheries research institutions.

## 6. Right to information

Additionally, fishers have the right to information about government policies and programmes that impact their livelihoods. This implies an obligation on relevant authorities to provide information to fishers about the state of resources, habitats and coastal zone management that would help hold decision-makers accountable to the decisions made.



# These rights and entitlements form the basis for ensuring a just, equitable and sustainable livelihood for marine fishers in Tamil Nadu.

More specifically, the Fisheries and Fishermen Welfare Department policy note 2022-23, outlines the major objectives of the Department of Fisheries in Tamil Nadu.

They are as follows:

#### **FISHER WELFARE**

- Protection of traditional fishing rights and welfare of fishermen of Tamil Nadu
- Improving the living standards of fishers through various welfare schemes
- Empowerment of fisherwomen in livelihood activities with a special focus on fisher widows
- Ensuring transparency in implementation and monitoring of developmental schemes and welfare measures through e-Governance
- Capacity building and skill upgradation for fishers
- Research & Development and technological interventions in the Fisheries sector

#### **ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT**

- Enhancing the productivity and production of fish from the Inland, Brackish and Marine resources
- Creation and upgradation of infrastructure facilities such as Government Fish Farms,
- Fishing Harbours (FHs)/Fish Landing Centres (FLCs), cold chain, value addition, forward and backward linkages
- Generating additional rural employment opportunities through fish culture
- Bridging the gap between the demand and supply of fish seed
- Harnessing the opportunity of expanding the export market for high value fish and fishery products

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL SAFEGUARDS**

- Conserving fishery resources, stock enhancement and management through enforcement of relevant Acts, Rules and Regulations
- Re-assessment of the fishery resources and their potential in the State of Tamil Nadu

Towards fulfilling these obligations, the Fisheries Department has entitlements directed towards fishing communities. These are listed in the sections in the next page.



# State Financial Assistance during Fishing Ban Period

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

The 61-day fishing ban period is implemented from April 15th to June 14th in the East Coast region and June 1st to July 31st in the West Coast region (Rajakkamangalamthurai to Neerodi). The Government is implementing a scheme for providing relief assistance to fisher crew and labourers of Rs. 6000/- to each marine fishermen family in coastal districts to mitigate their loss of livelihood during the fishing ban period.

# State Financial Assistance during Lean Period

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

To alleviate the loss of livelihood of the marine fishermen families who are actively involved in marine fishing activities, the Government of Tamil Nadu is extending relief assistance to marine fishermen families during lean fishing months.

# State Savings-cum-Relief Scheme for Marine Fisherwomen

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

This scheme is implemented as a State scheme for marine fisherwomen. The State Government contributes Rs. 3,000 and a sum of Rs. 4,500 including the fisherwomen contribution is disbursed to the applicants during the lean fishing months.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. Applicant should be a fulltime active fisherwoman
- 2. Applicant should be a member of a functional local fisher's cooperative society/ Federation/any other registered body.
- 3. Applicant should be Below Poverty Line (BPL) and of between 18 and 60 years of age
- 4. Applicant fishers shall save Rs.1500/- over a period of 9 months during the fishing season annually towards their contribution. Lump-sum contribution in a period of one or two months may be avoided.

# National Fisher Saving-cum-Relief Scheme (NFSRS) for Marine Fisher Families

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

In addition to the state schemes, the central government is implementing a scheme for providing relief assistance of Rs. 3000/- to each marine fishermen family in coastal districts to mitigate their loss of livelihood during the fishing ban period.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. Applicant should be a fulltime active fisher.
- 2. Applicant should be a member of a functional local fishers cooperative society/ Federation/any other registered body.
- 3. Applicant should be Below Poverty Line (BPL) and of between 18 and 60 years of age.
- 4. Applicant fishers shall save Rs.1500/- over a period of 9 months during the fishing season annually towards their contribution. Lump-sum contribution in a period of one or two months may be avoided.

# Supply of tax-exempted High Speed Diesel (HSD) **Tamil Nadu**

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

The Government of Tamil Nadu provides tax exempted diesel to the registered mechanized and motorized fishing boats.

# Supply of subsidized Industrial Kerosene to **Traditional Crafts**

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

The government is providing industrial kerosene of 3400 litres per motorized country boat per year at the subsidized rate to the fishing crafts of Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Districts.

# **Group Accident Insurance Scheme for Fisherfolk**

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

Under the PMMSY scheme, relief assistance is provided to deceased fishers or fishers with permanent or partial disability towards covering hospitalization expenses. The insurance cover shall be for a period of 12 months.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Licensed/Registered fishers enrolled in the Fishermen/Fisherwomen Co-operative societies and the fisher enrolled in Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board

#### **ENTITLEMENT**

Insurance premium@ Rs.20.34/- per fisher per year paid by the government.

# Daily relief to families of Missing Fishers

#### ABOUT THE SCHEME

The State Government is providing daily relief assistance of Rs. 350 (Rs. 10,500 per month) to the families of fishermen who went missing while fishing at sea for two years or until they receive monetary benefits through Group accident insurance scheme/Tamil Nadu Fishermen Welfare Board.

#### **ENTITLEMENT**

# Daily relief to marine fishermen apprehended by neighbouring countries

#### **ABOUT THE SCHEME**

The Government supports the families of fishermen who are apprehended by Sri Lanka and other neighbouring countries while fishing, by providing daily allowance of Rs. 250 to the family of the apprehended fishermen. The scheme is implemented through the District Collector's Office.






