FORGING NEW CONNECTIONS

Dakshin Endeavours was established in 2019 as a social enterprise that facilitates experiential learning and outdoor experiences for children across age groups. Together with Dakshin Foundation and ANET, DE has since conducted outdoor programmes that offer visiting groups of children an opportunity to explore the islands through walks, hikes and craft activities.



COMMUNITY AND CONSERVATION

The collaborative team of DE & ANET together facilitate outdoor learning experiences for children to explore the biodiversity and learn more about the history of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands through birding walks, forest hikes, mat-weaving, inter-tidal shore walks, documentary screenings etc.

With the aim of creating an equitable space for collaboration and cultural exchange, DE & ANET often bring together children from the local schools and visiting children from mainland India over a friendly match of *kho-kho*, *kilithattu* or football.

In other instances, children take over the ANET kitchen for a day to prepare local traditional dishes inspired by the various settler communities that call the islands their home.

These experiences allow children from tier-1 and tier-2 cities of mainland India who visit the islands gain a deeper understanding of the critical ecosystems, the social and cultural milieu and the conservation challenges that the islands face in the wake of changing landscapes.





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
