The role primarily involves conceptualising, designing and implementing communication strategies for the programme.

Key Responsibilities

- Conceptualise, design, and produce visual communication materials including infographics, briefs, newsletters, reports, and social media content.
- Copy edit, proofread, and refine reports, briefs, and publications to high editorial standards.
- Maintain a repository of communication assets and develop templates to manage and streamline workflow.
